Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors (“Board”) of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting, in person and open to the public, on **Tuesday, March 24, 2026, at 1:00 p.m.**, at **17332 Groeschke Road, Houston, Texas 77084**, a designated meeting place of the District, and limited participation may be permitted by videoconference per Texas Government Code Sec. 551.027 (**see below and the District website www.hcmud238.com for details). The Board may consider and authorize any action related to:

3. Review proposed Series 2026 Bonds, including:
 - a. Order from Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and funding schedule options;

 - ii. distribute credit packages to S&P and two bond insurers;
